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Saguaro National Park

The Organic Act of 1916 created the National Park Service "to conserve the scenery and the natural and historic objects and wildlife therein, and to provide for the enjoyment of the same in such manner and by such means as will leave them unimpaired for the enjoyment of future generations." Each national park or monument offers a glimpse into the natural beauty and history of the United States. These parks have a variety of natural resources covering large areas and are protected by the American Antiquities Act of 1906. Saguaro National Park is home to its namesake giant saguaro cacti, barrel cacti, cholla cacti, and prickly pears, as well as quail, spotted owls, javelinas, and a host of other flora and fauna. Saguaro National Monument was created by outgoing president Herbert Hoover in 1933. On October 14, 1994, Pres. William Jefferson Clinton signed legislation enlarging Saguaro's boundaries and making Saguaro National Park America's 52nd national park.

In our first eBook *Quest to the West* (ISBN 9781456623357), my wife Patricia and I used photographic images and poetry to capture the stunning landscapes from the National Parks of the American Midwest. This second eBook, *Arizona Rising* is a photographic exploration of our trips to the canyon lands of Arizona in the fall of 2013 and spring 2014. You will see beautiful images of Saguaro National Park including a variety of very prickly cacti and birds of prey that frequent this desert area. The main views from the Sedona area are images of Cathedral Rock and sights aboard the northern Verdi Railroad. In the Painted Desert you can see the multicolored buttes and mesas of the badlands. From a completely different viewpoint, the images will take you into the Antelope slot canyon near Page. On these pages you will see images of deep, flowing spiralling rock formations expressed in beautiful shades of red, orange, beige and black. Monument Valley offers huge vistas of sandstone, mesas,

buttes and spires that characterize this region of the Colorado plateau. Finally, I will take you into the north rim of the Grand Canyon I was able to capture the ethereal beauty of Bright Angel Point.

Arizona Rising

The Tucson Mountains are located several miles west of downtown Tucson. For thousands of years, this mountain range has been inhabited, explored, and traveled by Native Americans who settled near the Santa Cruz River. Atman is not a universal self in the sense that everyone has an atman, but rather atman is a particular construction of the self which is both explicitly male and gained through particular kinds of practices which are primarily the domain of men.

We have a significant number of characters in Upanisadic stories who, based on earlier textual material, would normally be excluded from such knowledge. Taken together their inclusion appears to be more of an internal critique and development of the Brahmin worldview and less of a reflection of an historical reality. If women in this Upanishad are viewed in this light, the issue appears to be a larger one of a changing ideology behind the possession of knowledge and what that knowledge is. 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Honduras, State for Sale

Honduras has been called the ""Pentagon Republic"" because of the vast military complex the US has constructed on its soil. But lack of national sovereignty is not new to Honduras. When strong local elites failed to emerge after Independence, the US banana companies soon dominated political and economic life, virtually choosing the country's presidents. Economic diversification since the second world war has not altered the basic themes of Honduran history: subservience to US interests, militarism, corruption and mass poverty. In pursuit of personal fortunes and political power, military and civilian elites have offered the country as a ""state for sale.""
