Exam problems focus on just two (p. 7) points (automatically a straight line!) and then ask about either the normal boiling point, when the vapor pressure would be 1 atm, or the molar enthalpy of vaporization, which is the slope. Getting the normal boiling point involves determining the slope first. Here is the equation to use

Trouton's Rule A liquid can be considered a completely disordered condensed phase A gas, likewise, is a completely disordered non- condensed phase. Thus, for most ordinary molecules, the entropy of vaporization is about the same, because the same amount of additional disorder is created by vaporizing anything at all. This is Trouton's Rule: the molar entropy of vaporization is about 87.5J mol⁻¹K⁻¹ for most molecules (at 1 atm pressure, the normal boiling point). Materials have different BPs due to a

Hydrogen Bonding Water has a much higher entropy of vaporization than Ar or H₂. It does not follow Trouton's Rule. This is probably because liquid water is not a completely disordered condensed phase: there is some order present from the hydrogen bonding. This order is disrupted in going to the vapor, where there is no hydrogen bonding.

H-bonds Disrupt The Trend Water, ammonia, and hydrogen fluoride boil at an unusually high temperature, due to their ability to form hydrogen bonds in the liquid. Methane, which cannot do so, follows the trend for the rest of the Group 4 elements.

Summary Condensed phases are far more complex than gases At a given pressure, two phases can coexist only at a fixed temperature. We do not yet have a good theory to be able to predict, for example, that water should freeze at 273.15 K @ 1 atm. Many solids form regular periodic arrays of atoms or ions: X-ray diffraction lets us look at their structures. The unit cell is the smallest unit in a crystal.
