Human beings can be divided into four 'blood groups' according to the agglutinating properties of their blood.

Both agglutin- ating factors

If the corpuscles of the individual to be tested are mixed with serum of groups a and b, the group can be ascertained.

Donor and patient should belong to same group, but in emergency donor of group o may be used for any patient.

Taking Blood From The Donor. Two ampoules each con-taining 1 gram of sodium citrate in concentrated solution are emptied into transfusion flask.

A light tourniquet is applied to the donor's upper arm and skin is cleaned.

A small bleb is raised over the distended vein in the antecubital fossa with plain Novocain solution 2%

A tiny nick made with point of scalpel for passage of large transfusion needle. (French's pattern.) Anterior wall of vein transfixed with half curved round bodied needle.

The vein is held by transfixing needle and transfusion needle is inserted underneath it into the lumen of the vein.

Blood is thoroughly mixed with citrate solution by gently swinging the flask.
