set the completion standards for each lesson

refrain from non-essential activities during critical phases of flight

reducing distractions during critical phases of flight

established a policy for use of certain distractions on practical tests

identify terrain or objects on the ground

relying on flight instruments from the beginning of flight

check post flight evaluation

keep all radio communications to a minimum

illustrating the stability of the aircraft

pilot supervision flight instructors have the responsibility to provide guidance

perform all of the fundamental maneuvers

stress touching down in the first third of the runway

need to document completion of prerequisites for a practical test

understanding the affecting use of the flight controls

fixing the relationship of the reference point on the airplane

maintaining a constant direction or heading

maintain straight flight by simply exerting the necessary pressure

trim the rudder

determine the rate of turn for a given airspeed

aileron and rudder control inputs

maintain a minimum air speed in the climb

requires advancing the propeller control prior to increasing engine power

maintain a constant airspeed in constant rate of turn

descend with partial power

gliding at airspeed above or below the best glide airspeed

advance the propeller lever forward with back pressure on the elevator

maintain or increase airspeed while raising the nose
