Nous avons le plaisir de vous informer que, demain, nous serons tués avec nos familles

Au printemps 1994, un massacre programmé décima, avec une rapidité stupéfiante, la République du Rwanda. Avec des moyens rudimentaires (à la machette, principalement), près d'un million de personnes furent exécutées en à peine cent jours, sur une population initiale de sept millions et demi d'habitants. Envoyé sur place comme reporter par le New Yorker, un an après le drame, Philip Gourevitch s'est fait l'historien-dramaturge de ce génocide perpétré par les Hutus contre les Tutsis. C'est à travers des centaines de témoignages, comme autant de fables édifiantes, et donc par la voix des Rwandais eux-mêmes (le titre est extrait de la lettre envoyée par un pasteur tutsi, la veille de l'extermination de son village, à son confrère hutu), qu'il révèle peu à peu la mécanique fatale, mise en place à l'époque coloniale, dont résultent ces conflits ethniques. Pièce par pièce, il démonte cette "fabrique du génocide ".

Présence francophone

Ce livre révèle la vérité sur l'opération « humanitaire » Turquoise, confiée à des militaires. Cette opération planifiée par les autorités françaises, contestée dès l'origine, commence douze jours seulement avant la chute de Kigali et la fin du génocide – douze jours entachés d'imposture militaire et politique et de choix très fautifs, selon Prungnaud. Cet ancien du GIGN sait de quoi il parle, il a fait Turquoise au sein du Commandement des forces spéciales. Acteur et témoin, il évoque un état-major français presque toujours pro hutu, dévoile des zones d'ombre, effrayantes, notamment à Bisesero entre le 27 et le 30 juin 1994, où plus d'un millier de Tutsis ont été massacrés et alors que, à proximité, la hiérarchie connaissait le danger qui pesait sur eux. Elle n'a donné aucun ordre pour les protéger. Il y a quelques années, la justice a été saisie d'une plainte contre l'État français pour « complicité de génocide et de crimes contre l'humanité ». Depuis, le tribunal aux Armées instruit – mollement. L'enquête serrée de L. de Vulpian s'appuie sur le témoignage du sous-officier. Elle met en évidence les faiblesses de la Mission parlementaire Quilès, la campagne de désinformation orchestrée par une poignée de hauts responsables militaires et politiques, notamment sous la plume de Péan, le positionnement très

« idéologique » – anti Tutsi – d'officiers supérieurs de Turquoise, ainsi que leurs mensonges. Cette enquête nous amène sur le terrain politique franco-français, expose les difficultés de la justice à faire la vérité sur le rôle de l'État français. Elle parle aussi des militaires qui, voulant accomplir leur devoir, ont outrepassé les ordres. Ils ont ainsi sauvé l'honneur sinon de la France, au moins des Français.
