Matrix of domination, is the sociological theory of paradigm, that deals with the issues of oppressions, that are related to gender, race, class, and sexual

Essentialism, is what a person believes to be universal, ambiguous, and inherent are the mere 'essences' that differentiate, one group from the other.

Institutional: -- Any person distinguishes himself within the various institutions that he has been living with like his family, educational institution, and the State.

Interpersonal: -- Interpersonal context depends how a person interact with the other person, which may or may not belong to his ethnicity

Internal context: -- Sometimes a person tries to put himself in the above two contexts and to accept the values and beliefs...

Is this an option for Black women professionals/academics? Does this practice uphold patriarchy? Does this practice negate the goals of Black feminism?

How do we divest in the inequitable forms of power perpetuated by patriarchy and heterosexuality while engaging with men intimately?

How can Black women practice or participate in social justice projects in such a way that they maintain autonomy, emphasize the particularities of Black feminism, and still prevent themselves from carrying the burden of doing the emotional work of nurturing others?

How would Black Feminism define protecting Black women and girls? How can non-Black women and girls (and also Black women and girls who aren’t already doing so) go about protecting each other?

Related to the last two questions, in what ways have/do you practice restorative justice through a Black Feminist mindset?

Today, many women rappers such as Nicki Minaj or Cardi B are celebrated for their openness. What do you believe to be the reason for this shift? Or, do you believe there is a shift at all?

How have Black women, inside and outside of the academy, created new ways of validating their own experiences, histories, and knowledge?

How can we transform this rhetoric by encouraging White people and others who subscribe to the notion of color blindness to understand intersectional oppression?

Are there any other characteristics that come to mind connected to this epistemology that would help ensure or remind members of the SBG book club of the importance of constructing knowledge and enacting change?

What has been your process of engaging with people who reside in the crossover space of family and individuals who do not see Black women as worthwhile, and when should I give up?
