Our brains are wired to learn to speak.

Baby brains are constantly taking statistics from their environment

Speech is the starting point for reading

This is how a strong reader's brain functions.

Reading starts as a visual input

It then enters the letterbox region, or the visual word formation area.

They can use their auditory lexicons to recognize the meaning of the word.

Once they know the letter sound correspondences, emerging readers can self teach fluency

Our brains process the sounds and meaning in parallel

Fluency can be trained by reading independently once a student knows the sound Symbol correspondences

The Letterbox the visual word form area

The way to overcome this is by teaching handwriting

The brain forms connections of fiber channels between letters and sounds.

This is an anatomical change that happens when we learn to read.

Learning to read changes how the brain codes phonemes sounds

Systematic teaching grapheme to phoneme correspondences makes the fastest change in the brain MRI scans can identify the neural pathways being developed in struggling readers vs strong readers. Reading in all languages requires connecting letters to speech sounds.

They can show as little as 4 hours of games matching phonograms to sounds begins to develop the letterbox area of the brain in 4-year-olds.
