For Slavists, it presents a way of looking at medieval Russian women that has not yet appeared in this scholarly tradition. Ultimately, this biography integrates Russia, and eastern Europe, into the medieval world and acts as an important reminder that women are essential to our history and thus to our overall understanding of the past.
