Overview - **Personal construct theory**, - Kelly's ...

Constructs • An intellectual hypothesis that we devise and use to interpret or explain life events.

Constructs are bipolar, or dichotomous, such as tall versus short or honest versus

Construction - Because repeated events are similar, we can predict what will happen. • Helping is good.

Experience - We continually test our constructs against life's experiences. e.g. Is it bad to steal if I'm hungry? . Is it a crime to kill if I'm

Modulation - We may modify our constructs as a function of new experiences. Key word: permeability.

Christmas. • Changing misconceptions (e.g. sexism, racism, discrimination)

Individuality - People perceive events in different ways. Having your own

Dichotomy - Constructs are bipolar

Range - Our constructs may apply to many situations or people, or they may be limited to a single person or situation. You can use "empathic" to describe a person, but can you use it to describe a

Commonality - People in compatible groups may hold similar constructs. Sociality - We try to understand how other people think and we modify our behavior accordingly.

Perception of deviance depends on others' reactions.

Deviant acts lead to labeling and override individual characteristics.

Labeling impacts opportunities and marginalization.

Formation of deviant identities and association with others.

Labeling influences the creation of laws.

Becker's focus on stigmatization of criminals, but lacks explanation for initial criminal activity and impacts on victims.
