China is known for its deep veneration of history. Far more than a record of the past, history to the Chinese is the *magister vitae* (teacher of life): the storehouse of moral lessons and bureaucratic

precedents. *Mirroring the Past* presents a comprehensive history of traditional Chinese historiography from antiquity to the mid-Qing period. Setting Qing dynasty culture in historical and global perspective, Smith shows how the Chinese of the era viewed the world; how their outlook was expressed in their institutions, material culture, and customs; and how China’s preoccupation with order, unity, and harmony contributed to the civilization’s remarkable cohesiveness and continuity.
