JP was treated conservatively using pain management, acupuncture, laser and physical rehabilitation. The treatment plan included strict cage rest.

The first 6 weeks following paralysis or hind leg weakness is the most crucial time to start neurological rehabilitation, as the spinal cord has the ability to regenerate. The dog's paws need to make contact with the ground for regeneration to occur.

Neuromuscular electrical stimulation helped to maintain muscle strength

Range of motion exercises were used for gait training and sensory stimulation. Flexor withdrawal exercises were used for sensory stimulation and muscle contraction

Laser therapy was used for pain relief and healing by promoting blood flow and nerve regeneration
