Section 4 gives details on how to perform several practical procedures, such as ciliary brush biopsy, flexible bronchoscopy and inserting a chest drain. The appendices provide information on lung function testing and tables of age-corrected normal values for several respiratory parameters. This book has been written by 2 consultants who work in a tertiary respiratory unit and a respiratory trainee. This combination of authors has provided the experience necessary to deal with topics where there is an absence of published evidence and to present the information in a format that both consultants and trainees will find useful.

The main role of a midwife is to prepare women for the delivery of new life and to also provide support and guidance during all stages of the pregnancy, throughout the process of labour itself and also during the early days of the postnatal process.

The main strengths I possess are an ability to remain calm under difficult and pressurized situations. As a Midwife, this is a core skill and without it, you won't be able to carry out your duties professionally.
