The experimental method gives the appearance of science, without necessarily having scientific rigor (Example: Jung's experiment with 10 words) (Another example: Diederik Staple's "faking sciences A true story of academic fraud", translated by Nicholas J.L. Brown)

A. Experimental psychology's approach puts too much emphasis on individuality in explaining behavior (they disconnect the individual from the social environment)

What people do depends on what is available to them! Culture makes some behaviors available in some situations. Culture also encourages/ discourages some behaviors in some situations.

Experimenters usually ignore external validity (if the same pattern of findings will be found in a real-life situation)

Experimenters ignore the looping effect (Ian Hacking) - findings can change the behavior of people who learn about them.

Summary: Experimental psychology is successful in giving the appearance of scientific rigor, and in producing results that are repeatable and reliable. However, there are debates and disagreements about the validity of experimental results, their relevance to real human life, and what they miss based on their assumptions about individualism (isolated minds) and causality.
