We Have Our Different Layers and They'Re All On There as Individual Items All Individually Selectable Which Is Great So Now What When To Do Is in the Top Left-Hand Corner Here You See You Have Auto Select Ticked if It's Uh Nicked What Happens Is You Just You'Re Always Working with that One and Then You Have To Select another Layer in the Layers Chart and Then Move that One if You Click Auto Select It Allows You To Click on the Flower and It Will Automatically Select that Layer So if You Look over Here on the Right I'M Just See Selecting Different Ones and that Just Makes It Much Easier When It Comes to Moving Your Images Around and Selecting Them and Playing with Them Okay Which Is Really Important

And the Easiest Way To Do that Is Simply To Cut the Top of this Print Remove this Top Edge Move It Down to the Bottom and Then Move that Edge Up the Top and that Way this Edge Here Will Be at the Bottom and this Edge Here Will Be at the Top So When You Tile Them Vertically They Will Match and We Do the Same for the Left and the Right but It's Always Easier if I Just Demonstrate So First of all

We Have All these Layers down the Side Here and All Our Individual Plants Which Is Great but We Want To Essentially Get all of these on the Same Layer so There One Item Okay Also at this Point I Would Suggest Saving this Document in Case You Want To Tweak or Play Around with this Layout Later

So Let's Go to Layer 16 Let's Go to the Top Hold Down the Shift Key and Click on the Top and this Will Select all of those Layers Apart from the Background We Do Not Want To Select the Background Layer and Then GonNa Right Click on Here and Just Glow Oops Hang Let's Go Down and Then Go Merge Layers Okay Now this Will Merge all of Our Flowers Together Which Is Looking Very Great and Also the Background Is GonNa Be Separate So Now Let's Get On with Our Full Repeat So Once Again Let Me Just Grab a Ruler So if We Hit ctrl R on Our Keyboard It Will Bring Up the Rulers And I'M Also GonNa Hold Down the Shift Key and Click and Drag over this Edge As Well and Then Then Just Going To Fill It with White So I'M Going To Double Click Here Make Sure that's White Click Ok Then Go Edit and Then Okay Make Sure the Layer Is Selected Edit and Then Fill Click Ok So I Now Have these Two White Strips So Now When I Cut this Upper Half So Edit Cut When I Move this Up You Can See that I Know Exactly Where the Edge of My Document Is Which Is Perfect So I'Ve Created some Almost like Registration Marks Also Nothing To Mention

And that Is Going To Match that Perfectly Otherwise Before without those White Edges You Know God Knows Where that Print Is Going To Be so that Just Collect Defined the Edges of Our Borders or Our Print Okay So Next We Have So Now We Know that the Top and the Bottom Match Okay That's a Repeat It's a Reverse Call Repeat but It's Not It's Not a Horizontal Repeat so What I Nice Do Is Simply Merge these Two Layers Together Want To Make Them One Entire Piece So Let's Just Select those Right Click and Then Go Down

You Know There Should Be some Little Pieces That Allow You To Find the Top and Bottom We Don't Need those White Bars Anymore because Look It's Locking Nicely because We Already Have some Information Here and Here Which Is Hard To See but It's There so It's Going To Slide that across to the some One Slide the Right Panel across to the Left and Then Your Edit and Paste in My Original Left Panel and Slide that Over to the Right like that Which Is Lovely So Now We Know the Top and the Bottom Repeat and the Left and the Right Repeat and Let's Just Get Rid of that Ruler and So Now You Can See

So Let's Just Turn this to You One Two Five so We'Re Going To Basically Increase the Canvas Size Not the Image Size but the Canvas Size Click Ok and So Now if I Go if I Select that Layer and Hit ctrl C To Copy and Then ctrl V To Paste You Can Now See that Hopefully this Works When I Put that in You Can See that It Repeats Left to Right and It Also Repeats Top to Bottom and that Is Essentially How You Create a Fully Repeating Print and It's Simple once You Get the Hang of It Okay There We Go However We'Ve Got a Slight Issue with Our Print So Let's Go Back Hitting ctrl Z We'Ll Go Back through Your Actions and Shift Controls Ed Will Go Forward

So I'M Just GonNa Get My Selection Tool I'M Going To Select this Flower and Only this Flower I Don't Want To Go into the Other Ones Just this Flower and Then I'M Giving It My Move Tool and It's Going To Move It Maybe into the Center Here and You Can Even Transform It Rotate It like You Did before You Can Even Scale It if You Want To Feel a Bit More Space so We'Re Just Going to Proportion these Flowers Out Same with this One Let's Just Move this One into the Center a Little Bit Let's Maybe Scale It Up a Tad

Just Move this One into the Center a Little Bit Let's Maybe Scale It Up a Tad We Can Rotate It Perhaps Move It Down Let's Maybe Go to this One Oops Make Sure the Layer Selected and Then We Can Just Maybe Scale this Up a Little Bit Perhaps Same with this One Just Move It over Oops You See I'M Taking a Little Bit of Edge There We Don't Want To Do that See that Flowers Getting Involved So Let's Just Make Sure We'Re Just Taking the Flower

So Next What We'Re Going To Do Is We'Re Going To Then Start To Look at Adding Obviously Changing the Colors of this Maybe Pulling Is Quite a Bright Print Maybe Pulling It down a Little Bit More Classic Also Adding a Bit More Color and Yeah Playing around the Hue and Saturation but Essentially that's How We Kind Of Create a Full Repeat Print from Our Source Imagery Okay So Let's Create some Color Effects and Play around this Print or Experiment with this Print a Little Bit More but First of all before We Do that We Have Our Full Repeat Here and I Want To Save this because any Changes I Make in the Future It's GonNa Be Hard To Go Back so It's Always Good To Save Your Work as You Go Along So Let's Just Save this as and Let's Call It Full Repeat Print Oops Four-Peat Print no Effects Click Okay Okay So Now Let's Play Around with this Print

I'M Going To Add a New Layer Which Is this Little Icon Down Here It's Click Add New Layer and as You Can See It Goes on the Very Very Top and You Can Rearrange these It Can Be below Your Flower Layer It Can Be on Top It Could Be Wherever You Want It To Be but Essentially for Now We Want To

Put this on Top of Our Flower Layer Okay That's Our Flower Layer and this Is Just a Layer That We Haven't Had Anything to Yet So Let's Just Zoom In and Show You What We'Re GonNa Do Here so We Have this New Layer and Up Here We Have a Whole Range of Different Filters We Can Add to that Layer and I'M Going To Click Color Okay and We Also Have Opacity You Can Change the Opacity of this As Well but I Want It About 100 %

And Then We'Re GonNa Go Over to When I Select a Color Now I Want To Play Around with Let's Say I Want To Add a Bit Pink to these Lilies They'Re a Little Bit Kind Of Dull Let's Go for a Nice Hot Pink Which Is this next Me When We Go to My Brush Tool Which Is Just Here and Then as You Can See You Got a Few Options and You Have Opacity You Have Normal and You Have the Size of Your Brush So at the Moment as You Can See if I Just Hover on the Page You Can See the Size of this Brush and To Be Fair It's Actually Quite a Nice Size I'M Happy with Size that Brush but You Can To Change It To Be Smaller

So this Is Pink So if I Go to Obviously this Is Our Color Layer I'M Going To Go to Image Adjustments and Then Hue and Saturation You Can Change Exposure Vibrant Color Balance All this Kind of Stuff You Can Play around these if You Want to Everything Will Create Something Different but I'M Going To Look at Hue and Saturation this Is a Very Easy Way To Change Colors of Your Print Very Quickly so Hue Obviously Will Change the Hue of that Color Layer So Now We'Re Getting into Oranges or Yellows

And Then Hue and Saturation You Can Change Exposure Vibrant Color Balance All this Kind of Stuff You Can Play around these if You Want to Everything Will Create Something Different but I'M Going To Look at Hue and Saturation this Is a Very Easy Way To Change Colors of Your Print Very Quickly so Hue Obviously Will Change the Hue of that Color Layer So Now We'Re Getting into Oranges or Yellows next We Enter Greens and Then Finally into Blues Other End of the Spectrum Different Kind of Blue Okay so this Is a Really Quick Way of Changing those Color Layers You Can Even Up the Saturation
