set the picket

clip two pockets to the same carabiner

put that ice screw right under the glacier wall clip

jump in a self arrest position

get in the seated position

cut a slot for the stem of that tea

fill in the long part of the t-slot

use that clove hitch as an anchor

put this clove hitch in with a little bit of slack

put on a pulley in this location

approaching a look at the crevasse

put myself in the locking carabiner

put my ice axe off to the side

put in an anchor

put padding on the left

pull myself up right near the lip

keep the rope from cutting deeper and deeper into the lip

combined with a pulley and a carabiner

put my prusik on the crevice side of this tractor

attaching the pulley

falling into the crevasse

so you need to tie some knots and their rope
