The Bible as the authority for Christian ethics In short, the argument from a biblicist perspective is

that the Bible alone is responsible for moral instruction being the word of Cod.

Heteronomous Christian Ethics For the heteronomous Christian ethicist, the Bible remains a significant source of authority, but recognises that as an ancient document, biblical writers do not always reflect contemporary society. In essence, this view of Christian ethies looks at biblical teaching, Church teaching and human reason.

Roman Catholic ethical heteronomy In Roman Catholicism, Christian Ethics derive from a number of sources - the natural world, reason, conscience and Church authority. This combination is referred to as Natural Law.

In addition to divine and natural Law, moral conduct is also informed by the Magisterium, or teachings of the Church. These are in the form of a Papal encyclical - essentially the official position of the Church on a certain matter.

Problems with sources Just as theonomous ethical theory has problems with contradictions, heteronomous ethical theory has problems with sources of authority. Not least which sources are legitimate and should some be a greater authority than others.
