Establishing shot: a shot that shows the relationship between characters.

Mid-shot: taking a photo from the waist up

point of veiw: where you see everything that the characters see.

Wide shot shows everything on the set.

Canted angle: Camera angle deliberatley slanted to one side, usually for dramatic effect.

High angle: The camera angle is from an eye line looking down.

Low angle: Camera placed below the object looking up at it.

Hand Held: a hand held camera, it creates a shakey effect.

pan: television or cinema shot taken with the the camera rotating horizontaly to take the scene.

Tilt: a shot taken camera

Track: a camera that has been mounted on a wheeled platform that is pushed on rails.

Zoom: when you are more close up to the image.

Reverse zoom: when you move away from the image.

composition: what and how objects are composed in the frame.

Frame: everything that is in a frame.

Rule of thirds: guidelines of creating an illusion of an image to create an area of interest.

Deep focus: A camera that takes close and distant frames very clearly.

Audience: The spectators or listeners assembled at a performane of some kind.

Representation: Refers to the construction of any medium of aspects of reality such as people, places ECT.

Verisimilitude: The apperance of being real or true.

Editing: correcting or condensing a piece of music, tv or film.

Eyeline match: is a film editing technique associated with the continuity editing system.

Insert: media that has been inserted into a tv recording or film, E.G. music.

Dissolve: A act or instance of moving gradually from one picture to another.

Long take: A shot that continues for an unusualy lengthy time before the transition to the next shot.

Slow motion: playing back the film so it appears slower than in real life.

Superimposition: To put a picture or person on another picture so they can be seen at the same time.

Wipe: where the existing picture seem to be wiped out and replaced with a new image.

Fade: An act of causing a picture to darken and disapear gradually.

Elipsis: this is used to show that there is a gap in time E G at work then next hour he/she is at the gym.

Mise en scene the arrangement of props to represent the place where the movie is enacted.

Costume: A set of clothes in a style to match the film or plays era or the theme within.

Location: a actual place or natural setting in which film or radio broadcast is made, as distinct from a simulation studio.

Lighting: The arrangemeent or effects of light.

Colour design: this is used ot set a particular mood in the play or movie.

diegetic sound: the sound you can imagine the characters to hear.

Non diegetic sounds the characters cannot hear E.G. theme tune.

Direct address: talking directly to the audience.

Sound effect: sound effects have been added later (not real).

Score: Orchestral composition that accompanies the text.
