The series aims to fill in gaps in theory and practice in the Sendai Framework, and provides additional resources, methodologies, and communication strategies to enhance the plan for action and targets proposed by the Sendai Framework. poliédrica de los resultados alcanzados por dicho proyecto en el año 2021, en el ámbito de los dos grandes objetivos que se marcaron al inicio del mismo: a) Categorizar las concepciones del profesorado (en formación y en ejercicio) sobre la Historia y la Geografía escolares y analizar el peso de las mismas como posibles obstáculos para la transformación de los modelos didácticos. b) Evaluar las representaciones y estereotipos socioculturales presentes en el profesorado en formación y en ejercicio y su incidencia en el proceso de enseñanza/aprendizaje. Este libro ofrece, por tanto, el desarrollo de un proyecto y la consecución de unos objetivos que, más allá del diagnóstico, han mostrado la importancia de la necesaria implicación del profesorado para promover una renovación profunda en el sistema escolar en sus distintos niveles. Dicha mejora de la enseñanza y aprendizaje escolar pasa por cambios institucionales, organizativos, epistemológicos, metodológicos que necesariamente debe implicar un autocuestionamiento de la praxis y la identidad profesional, especialmente si entendemos la educación como un derecho y un motor para la participación de la ciudadanía en la esfera pública democrática. Pero sin el compromiso personal, subjetivo, es difícil avanzar en la mejora deseada.

Esta Tesis Doctoral, realizada desde el enfoque de los Derechos Humanos, la perspectiva de género, la historia comparada y la teoría actual de los movimientos sociales, investiga las razones nacionales e internacionales de la creación e implementación de Educación para la Ciudadanía y los Derechos Humanos en el sistema educativo español durante el Gobierno socialista de Rodríguez Zapatero, así como las reacciones frente a la misma, ilustrándolas con las generadas en Castilla-La Mancha, Castilla y León y Madrid (elegidas por su condición de comunidades autónomas de signo político opuesto y de diferente nivel de religiosidad social). Se subraya que la movilización contra Educación para la Ciudadanía y los Derechos Humanos tiene componentes tanto discursivos como emocionales y tanto locales como transnacionales, estos últimos aportados por el choque entre el discurso de las organizaciones internacionales y el discurso laico de Rodríguez Zapatero, con el discurso neoevangelizador de la Santa Sede secundado por la Conferencia Episcopal Española, un discurso destinado a hacer frente al avance de la perspectiva de género que actualmente permea la ONU y al progreso del laicismo en los viejos bastiones del cristianismo, como España. Se comprueba el efectivo impacto que tal proceso movilizador ha producido en las políticas educativas nacionales y comunitarias, en los contenidos de los libros de texto, en las respuestas de la Administración Pública a las demandas educativas de la ONU, el Consejo de Europa y la UE y, en suma, en el déficit de formación democrática de los ciudadanos.
