These vegetables can usually be planted once the soil is workable. (40°F and up)

Conditioning our soil is a vital step at the start of our growing season.

Our pH in our raised beds typically around 6.5.

We added about 1.5 of this organic compost (4 cm).

Organic matter like compost helps soil hold onto nutrients that plants need to develop.

This compmest will also help with moisture retention.

Soil test kits are an inexpensive way to see any nutrient defficiencies.

We use an all-purpose organic fertilizer (following bag instructions).

Pulverized Azomite contains over 70 trace minerals!

The trellis on this bed is 4' tall (120 cm).

The Seeding Square really cuts down on planting time.

Germination in cooler soil typically takes about 7-10 days.

Leave us a comment: What do you like to plant alongside your peas?

If we were planting spinach seeds, we would use the square.

Spinach spacing is typically 2-4 (5-10 cm).

Spinach can grow in soil as cool as 40°F (4-5°C).

Most radishes take just over a month to mature.

These seeds should germinate in a week or less.

Radishes can be planted as soon as the soil is workable.

Radishes do not like the heat, so container planting is a good option later in the season.

Because employers and politicians initially supported Asian immigrants, early manifestations of antipathy often appeared just as another dispute between capital and labour. But as their number increased, complaints about Asians became widespread, and racial characteristics became the nucleus of such terms as a 'white man's province' -- a 'catch phrase' which, as Roy notes, 'covered a wide variety of fears and transcended particular economic interests.' The Chinese were the chief targets of hostility in the nineteenth century; by the twentieth, the Japanese, more economically ambitious and backed by a powerful mother country, appeared more threatening. After Asian disenfranchisement in the 1870s, provincial politicians, freed from worry about the Asian vote, fueled and exploited public prejudices. The Asian question also became a rallying cry for provincial rights when Ottawa disallowed anti-Asian legislation. Although federal leaders such as John A. Macdonald and Wilfrid Laurier shared a desire to keep Canada a 'white man's country,' they followed a policy of restraint in view of imperial concerns. The belief that whites should be superior, as Roy points out, was then common throughout the Western world. Many of the arguments used in British Columbia were influenced by anti-Asian sentiments and legislation emanating from California, and from Australia and other British colonies. Drawing on almost every newspaper and magazine report published in the province before 1914, and on government records and private manuscripts, Roy has produced a revealing historical account of the complex basis of racism in British Columbia and of the contribution made to the province in these early years by its Chinese and Japanese residents.
