Milton Keynes didn't exist at this point. Well at least not as it is now. The city was part of a new development project in the 1960s. Before that the area was mostly farmland with very small population. It was inhabited ever since the bronze age it just never was an established city or even a town until the 1960s. This could have been more than three or even less, it's hard to prove where one was born in the 12th century. Not many birth certificates where printed out at that time.

Technically he was only a "master of the scholars" since the chancellery didn't exist yet but in practice he basically over saw all the day to day administrations of the University just like a chancellor would. Another reason for staying may have been that Cambridge had a presence of ecclesiastical courts for the bishopric of Ely meaning students and specially law students would have had a great opportunity to work in the town as well as learn.

Although he wasn't the most subtle person in his portrayal of history and definitely had his own set of biases in his writings, specially against the Irish.

Or just clerical law, which often times superseded the University law as the University was a beneficiary of the catholic church.

I show them being hanged within the city's wall due to simplicity sake however they where hanged outside of the city. Also it wasn't just the people that declared the students as guilty. The mayor of the city was there as well and he was the one to carry out the official verdict.

This problem was also prolonged due to the quarrel between the pope and the King of England at the time. As such the church was in no position until 1214 to resolve such problems.

There was no set date of end for this but it ended 470 years later when the Mayor and the University reached an agreement. The City also had to pay the university each year on St Scholastic day. Third one being Thomas Aquinas.
