To load the warp on a loom, each warp thread is first passed through an eyelet and then a comb The shuttle will carry the weft threads back and forth across the loom

The weaver uses pedals to control two frames

Together the frames separate the warp threads

The weaver passes the weft through the space created between the warp threads

After every pass she alternates the frames, interlacing the weft between the warp

She beats the weft threads close together with the comb

One pass at a time, the plain-woven cloth is finished
