Frederick Douglass was born near Hillsboro, Maryland, in February of 1818.

At the age of 12, Frederick began receiving reading lessons from the wife of his ``master," even though it was illegal to teach slaves to read.

A few years later, in 1845, Frederick Douglass published a book, his autobiography.

As his reputation grew, Douglass became an advisor to Abraham Lincoln and Andrew Johnson.

Douglass met with Lincoln to advocate on behalf of the soldiers.

Douglass, along with many others, spoke out for equal citizenship and the emancipation (freeing) of all slaves.
