Why Would There Be an Implication You'd See Two of Them but You Wouldn't See the Third One but It Doesn't Even Say that It Says I See the Son of Man Standing on the Right Hand of God on Gods an Invisible Spirit He Fills the Universe What Is His Right Hand It's Not a Physical Location but throughout Scripture It Refers to the Power of God Exodus 15 6 Thy Right Hand O God Is Glorious and Power He Delivered It Roll by His Right Hand It Wasn't a Physical Right Hand That Came Out and Pulled Him across the Red Sea but It Was the Power of God so Stephen Saw Jesus as the Glorified Christ Not Just the Humble Servant as He Walked around Earth but Invested with All the Power and Authority of God He Saw Him with the Glory of God

But He Addressed Him Lord Jesus Receive My Spirit Now if He Saw Two People Standing Side-by-Side He Ignored One of Them because He Simply Called on Jesus So I Believe that He Saw Jesus Christ in His Glorified Divine Role on the Right Hand of God Just as Jesus Said You'Re GonNa See the Son of Man Coming in the Clouds at the Right Hand of Power Matthew 26 64 We'Re Not GonNa See Two People Coming Down in the Clouds Together One on Somebody Else's Hand but We'Re GonNa See Jesus Christ whether Enveloped with All the Power of God at the Right Hand Position So To Speak and that's Exactly What Stephen Saw So It's Consistent with My What I've Explained to You that There's One God Fully Revealed in Jesus Christ Jesus God Is Not Masked or Hidden behind Three Masts That's Not the Terminology
