Elements of Darwin's Theory Common descent (proposed by Erasmus Darwin) Natural selection as the main driver of evolution and the explanation for why animals fit their environments

Evolution by natural selection if and only if: there is variation in a population • that variation is heritable • heritable variations are linked to different rates of reproductive success

But some people almost immediately went from this as a description, to a normative claim: "nature is a big competition, survival is the only prize, and eating the weak is a good thing"

"Darwin's work is most important and suits my purpose in that it provides a basis in natural science for the historical class struggle." . - Marx; 16 January 1861

Alfred Russell Wallace: groups which cooperate are more efficient than groups with in-group competition therefore co-operation will spread and take over the world inheritance interferes with within-group selection, so should be abolished the subjugation of women interferes with sexual selection, so should also be abolished

Eugenics Francis Galton (Darwin's cousin) thought the theory entailed that we needed to intervene to make people fitter, because civilization let the un-fit survive and reproduce

By the mid 20th century, Galton's version was defining public policy: "by 1940 sterilisation laws had been passed by thirty American states, three Canadian provinces, a Swiss canton, Germany, Estonia, all of the Scandinavian and most of the Eastern European countries, Cuba, Turkey and Japan." (Paul,

p.230)

Eugenics in Canada The Alberta Eugenics Board continued to sterilize people until they were dismantled in 1972 99% of cases that came before the board were approved for sterilization Thousands were sterilized without their consent, mostly young people, women, and aboriginals

Sociobiology . 1960s to 1970s was the heyday . Based on the idea that all animal societies may be subject to general laws of sociality

Sociobiologists attempted to use a mix of game theory and population genetics to explain selfless and selfish behaviour in animal societies

High School Students' Understanding and Problem Solving in Population Genetics

Mutual-fund superstar Peter Lynch and author John Rothchild explain the basic principles of the stock market and business in an investing guide that will enlighten and entertain anyone who is high-school age or older. Many investors, including some with substantial portfolios, have only the sketchiest idea of how the stock market works. in America drinks Coke or Pepsi, but only a very few own shares in either company or even understand how to buy them. Every student studies American history, but few realize that our country was settled by European colonists financed by public companies in England and Holland—and the basic principles behind public companies haven't changed in more than three hundred years. In Learn to Earn, Lynch and Rothchild explain in a style accessible to anyone who is high-school age or older how to read a stock table in the daily newspaper, how to understand a company annual report, and why everyone should pay attention to the stock market. They explain not only how to invest, but also how to think like an investor.

At the age of 32, when he was a married farmer, father-of-three, violinist and free-born man, he was kidnapped in Washington D.C and shipped to New Orleans, sold to a planter and enslaved for a dozen years. When he gained his freedom, he wrote his famous memoir and spent some years lecturing across the US,on behalf of the abolitionist movement. 'Twelve Years a Slave' was published a year after 'Uncle Tom's Cabin' by Harriet Beecher Stowe and built on the anti-slavery momentum it had developed. Northup's final years are something of a mystery, though it is thought that he struggled to cope with family life after being freed.
