Need to attach to caregiver: Children typically attach with the caregiver who they are with the most Toddlers are focused on gaining more independence. Asserting their opinions, wants, needs, preferences are a great way to do this.

Don't take it personally or get jealous. This can actually reinforce the dynamics

Instead ask yourself: What can I learn here? What works for my child?

Kids change their mind often . They're still learning about relationships and they change (just as we do)

If you're the unfavored parent. spend more 1:1 time with them.

Discipline should be between all caregivers/parents not just one.

Avoiding forcing your child to like you/connect with you. It's not your kids job to make you feel good as a parent. It's best to figure out what works for your child rather than having them try to accommodate your needs and feelings.
