Violence rears itself in ugly reality in Give Away. Erotic love appears in Classicism and The Tickle of Your Beard as well as Walking on the Sand Spit In February. The pain of loss is prevalent throughout the book and the imagery both literal and figurative permeates the work bringing us to the original question "Can
