repeat that process a couple more times

adding the stitch in a few more places

pull apart the feather a little bit

add another feather

cut strips of tissue paper

grab some clear tape

cut most of this paper tissue paper off

stitch it into place

hold the two sides of the ribbon

pull out my feathers

pin this into place

layering your feather trim

line up the top of the ribbon

pin it into place

sew at the top
