Then, during my recovery, after having an annual mammogram, I was told that I had breast cancer again and had to have a double mastectomy. Each new day is a step deeper into what He has for me. The devil seems to be trying to delay or stop this message from getting out, but all it has done is reiterated that through my storms and suffering God gets the glory! I have learned that in my weakness He shines more to those around me as I give Him honor for every blessing and continue to praise Him even through my sorrows. My faith grows because I know that as long as I am living, He is not done with me. It starts with saying, "This is the day I will begin to follow Christ with all of me no matter what comes my way." Over the past sixteen years, during my search for His calling, God has used dreams, people, and His still small voice to guide me through the process of writing this devotional. This book was written as God gave me revelation to the steps in finding my calling. I like to have things told to me straight and to the point. I feel God has given it to me in easy-to-understand, with-no-fluff guidelines. He knows what we need. I have heard from people of all ages desperate to have God give them an audible direction for their calling. We have to be in a place to hear Him, and I have outlined some of those for you. I had to walk through this devotional for my life to be able to finish it for you. Each chapter was another step for me to follow so I could see His direction clearly. Fulfilling Your Ministry Calling

How to Fulfill Your Calling You know that God has a purpose for your life, and a ministry for you to carry out. But how can you find out exactly what your ministry calling is? Can you do it by answering a questionnaire or doing a personality test? Do you need a prophet to give you a prophetic word to tell you what God has called you to do? Ministry vs. Calling One of the first things I had to learn on this journey into fulfilling my calling, was that ministry and calling were not the same thing. I found that many of the desires I had for ministry were based more on my experiences in life than they were on a unique calling from God. So what was the best thing to do? Until I could find out exactly what my calling was, I had to start doing something. I had to see what ministry opportunities were available and get started. Then as I tried different kinds of ministry, a picture began to form. Over time, I slowly began to see more clearly what my life destiny would look like. I am sure that you have found yourself in the same position. There are many desires burning in you and things that you would like to do in ministry. There are specific needs you would like to fill and specific people whom you feel a compassion for. But

is this your calling? It could be, but the chances are that God has something different for you. Levels of Ministry One of the first things you need to realize as you look at the subject of ministry, is that there are many different levels of ministry that you can get involved in. These start from the lower levels of basic ministry and lead up to the highest levels of Ministry Office. And lying between these is a whole list of possible things you could do in ministry. Gifts and Abilities What gifts and abilities do you have that will make you more effective in ministry? Do you know what God has given you? Do you know what you will need to do some of the things you want to do? And do you know how to go about getting these things if you do not have them? What About the Godhead? Did you realize that the Lord Jesus, the Holy Spirit and God the Father all have different roles to play in your ministry calling? Each are involved in different levels and different kinds of ministry. And often your readiness for your calling is dependent on how well you know each member of the Godhead. What About Training? What kind of training do you need to do the work of the ministry? Do you need to go and spend years at a Bible College? Do you need to study and get degrees before you can do the work of the ministry? And once you have these qualifications, how do you use them to fulfill your calling? What About Mentorship Then there is the popular idea these days of finding a mentor to teach you how to do the work of the ministry. What exactly is the role of the mentor, and how will this prepare you better to do the work of the ministry? And is this what will finally help you to find your ministry calling? Who is Your Spiritual Parent? If you think mentorship is new and radical then you have not come close to realizing all that is involved in full ministry training. But even here there is still a lot of confusion. What exactly does a spiritual parent do, and what is the main difference between a mentor and a spiritual parent? Most of the time these two are confused, and because nobody really knows how it works there are few who eventually come to the place where they can finally say, "I know what God has called me to do. The ultimate decision however, is up to the individual. So, at the age of 15, I made my personal/individual decision to answer the call of the streets and follow in my father's path. However, this did not, nor has it to this day, stopped my mothers' prayers and encouragement she had for me...thank you Mom. I Love you!Now me being a grown man, reflecting back on my childhood, and knowing my Calling, I feel like Paul when he said that he learned the secret of being content in any situation. He told them about his situation in prison. Now, like Paul, I express the joy of my walk with Christ. There are challenges in this prison environment, and it seems that every day is a struggle for me, but I have learned what you have to do to go on with hope. That is putting on the armor of God. Ephesians 6:10-18. Every day you're going to be faced with something or tested by Satan. As I began to live my Calling for Christ, at one point in time I had to ask myself what makes you any different from Job? Also, what makes you any different from Paul? Now at this point, God was trying to tell me something and that was to get on the path of righteousness...but, here I go being disobedient to God's word. I am grateful for God's mercy and love, because He lovingly set me down again to get my attention. I want you to know brothers and sisters, that what has happened to me has really served to advance and join others who are spreading the true

Gospel (Good News about Jesus Christ) so that it will be known throughout the whole world especially to those who are in prison. And to all the rest, who know about my walk, when I was hanging, slanging, and banging... living for Satan, I want you to know that now, God has shown me that my imprisonment is my Calling to do work for the advancement of the Kingdom of God through Christ Jesus and the Holy Spirit.
