Seriously, if you are a normal human being who is bored with just riding down to the local bikers café, or the seaside, on alternate Sundays with a bunch of your mates; and have been consumed by an overwhelming desire to drag your bike around this amazing world for a while, but need some ideas on how to do it, some advice to put your mind at ease, or just some words to convince yourself you should never have thought of doing such a stupid thing in the first place, this book could be for you.

Learning to master a motorcycle is nothing like driving a car. BikerCraft has been independently verified by an Advanced Police Examiner with over 34 years' worth of experience. BikerCraft is the culmination of 40 years riding experience, including 6 years as a motorcycle instructor. I completed a Police Advanced Motorcycle Training Scheme at the age of 17 and gained my full motorcycle licence shortly after my 17th birthday. A year later, I qualified as an Instructor for Star Rider working in Wythenshawe, Manchester. After working for them for 3 years, I became a Motorcycle Instructor for BSM (Manchester) for 3 years. During my time at BSM I completed annual Police Advanced Assessments. During the past 40 years I've ridden somewhere around 200,000 motorcycle miles across the UK and have toured across / through France, Spain, Italy, Switzerland, Germany, Austria, Holland and Belgium frequently. Touring / camping was usually done 2-up with a fortnight's worth of kit loaded on the bike and I can tell you that BikerCraft works everywhere !

On February 16 2016, motorcycle adventurer Charley Boorman suffered a major road traffic accident in Portugal. Having spent the better part of his life on some form of motorbike, his world came crashing down after he was knocked off a Triumph Tiger Explorer, smashing his right ankle and causing severe damage to his left fibia and tibia. It was unclear if he would ever walk properly again, let alone ride a motorbike.
