Buku ini membahas pemahaman dan tata laksana penyakit jantung koroner berdasarkan panduan terbaru di masa sekarang. Besar harapan, buku ini memberikan manfaat kepada dokter, tenaga medis, tenaga kesehatan, mahasiswa kedokteran maupun mahasiswa kesehatan, dan lain-lain. -- Buku "Penyakit Jantung Koroner" merupakan salah satu buku yang membahas update mengenai penyakit jantung koroner, bukan hanya dalam fase akut melainkan juga pada fase kronik penyakit. Selain itu, penjelasan mengenai patofisiologi dan rasional dari tindakan juga memudahkan tidak hanya klinisi, namun juga mahasiswa kedokteran dan kesehatan dalam membacanya.

Patofisiologi Dasar Keperawatan Penyakit Jantung Koroner

Menurut World Heart Organization (2015) 17,5 juta jiwa meninggal setiap tahun dan 31% dari kematian di seluruh dunia diakibatkan karena penyakit kardiovaskular. Penyakit jantung koroner terbanyak karena aterosklerosis yang sangat berkaitan dengan gangguan metabolisme lipid dan inflamasi. Inflamasi merupakan respons terhadap cedera yang terjadi di dinding vaskular. Cedera ini diakibatkan oleh oxidized low-density lipoprotein (oxLDL) yang berperan sebagai aktor utama dalam respons inflamasi dan dimediasi oleh monosit dan limfosit-T. Tingginya angka kesakitan, kecacatan dan kematian akibat penyakit jantung menuntut kemampuan tenaga kesehatan baik perawat maupun dokter untuk memahami patofisiologi dasar penyakit. Buku ini disusun untuk memenuhi kebutuhan pengetahuan mahasiswa kesehatan, baik perawat maupun dokter untuk memahami konsep dasar patofisiologi penyakit jantung koroner. Penulisan buku ini bertujuan untuk menjelaskan proses inflamasi vaskuler yang terjadi pada penyakit jantung koroner. Keunggulan buku ini adalah menggunakan hasil penelitian sebagai evidence ilmiah dalam mengembangkan suatu konsep dan teori. Rekam jejak penelitian yang telah dilakukan oleh penulis sangat mendukung kompetensi pengembangan wawasan dan ilmu di

bidang kardiologi molekuler. Sehingga sangat diharapkan tersusunnya buku ini untuk dimanfaatkan oleh mahasiswa kesehatan baik keperawatan, kedokteran, maupun bagi para peneliti di bidang kardiovaskuler.

Lifestyle of Determinant: Penderita Penyakit Jantung Koroner

Penyakit Jantung Koroner (PJK) menjadi masalah kesehatan dunia. Laporan World Health Statistic 2008, tercatat 17,3 juta orang meninggal dunia atau setara dengan 30 persen kematian di seluruh dunia disebabkan PJK. Tahun 2011, di negara Asia dan Pasifik telah terjadi 17.050 kematian disebabkan penyakit jantung, 7.825 kematian karena PJK dan 2.476 kematian karena infark miokard. Prevalensi PJK terjadi di seluruh negara, diproyeksikan di negara maju dan berkembang PJK menjadi penyebab utama kematian selama 20 tahun ke depan. WHO sepuluh tahun terakhir melaporkan negara-negara berpenghasilan rendah dan menengah lebih dari 80 persen kematian akibat PJK dapat ditemukan, PJK menjadi penyebab kematian dan kecacatan nomor satu di dunia. Era global di daerah tertentu di Indonesia trend perilaku gaya hidup sehat dipengaruhi oleh gaya hidup tidak sehat masyarakat; minum kopi, merokok, pola makan, aktivitas fisik dan pengendalian stres tidak tertata dengan baik sehingga akan mengakibatkan PJK. Terhadap perilaku hidup tidak sehat ini, dapat dilakukan pencegahan melalui promotif dan preventif, pencegahan PJK melalui kebijakan bersyariat yang berwawasan syariat Islam atau budaya dari kearifan lokal. Buku ini membantu mengatasi pencegahan PJK. Gizi & Penyakit Kronis

Buku ini adalah kumpulan karya yang mendalam dan komprehensif dari berbagai penulis yang berfokus pada gizi dan penyakit kronis. Setiap bab menguraikan dengan cermat bagaimana aspek-aspek nutrisi dan pola makan memengaruhi perkembangan serta pengendalian berbagai penyakit kronis yang sering terjadi pada masyarakat. Patofisiologi untuk Vokasi Keperawatan

Patofisiologi adalah studi tentang perubahan yang terjadi pada sel, jaringan, dan organ ketika mengalami gangguan oleh penyakit dan/atau cedera pada efek fungsi tubuh yang normal. Fokus utama dalam buku ini adalah menghubungkan fungsi tubuh normal terhadap perubahan patologis yang terjadi dan dapat menyebabkan proses penyakit. Dari pemahaman ini, tenaga kesehatan dapat belajar mengenali dan mengkategorikan berbagai etiologi, patologi, dan gambaran klinis dari penyakit. Buku ini disusun secara khusus untuk mahasiswa vokasi keperawatan atau bidang kesehatan lainnya serta memberikan pendahuluan patofisiologi yang mudah dipahami, jelas, tepat, dan komprehensif. Konsep-konsep yang berkaitan dengan patofisiologi keperawatan dibahas mulai dari pengertian, penyebab, dan pencegahannya ke dalam masing-masing bab.

Heart Disease

Di Indonesia salah satu penyakit kardiovaskular yang terus-menerus menempati urutan pertama adalah penyakit jantung koroner. Berdasarkan diagnosis/gejala, estimasi jumlah penderita penyakit jantung koroner terbanyak terdapat di Provinsi Jawa Timur sebanyak 375.127 orang (1,3%), sedangkan jumlah penderita paling sedikit ditemukan di Provinsi Papua Barat, yaitu sebanyak 6.690 orang (1,2%). PJK terutama terjadi karena aterosklerosis. Yang paling mendasari terjadinya PJK yaitu dislipidemia aterogenik yang dapat memicu pembentukan plak aterosklerosis di arteri koroner. Dislipidemia aterogenik yang telah dikenal antara lain peningkatan trigliserida, peningkatan asam lemak bebas, penurunan kolesterol HDL, rasio kolesterol/kolesterol HDL yang meningkat, dan peningkatan small dense LDL (sd-LDL). Terdapat beberapa mekanisme yang terlibat dalam patogenesis aterosklerosis pada Penyakit Jantung Koroner (PJK), salah satu mekanisme yang menjadi topik hangat adalah proses inflamasi. Ada beberapa sitokin sebagai reaksi inflamasi dan kerusakan jaringan pada pasien penyakit jantung koroner antara lain Interleukin 6 (IL-6), Interleukin 1 (IL-1), Tumor Necrosis Factor (TNF $\pm$) IL-6 khususnya, sitokin inflamasi kuat yang dihasilkan oleh beberapa jenis sel, termasuk makrofag yang teraktivasi, sel endotel dan otot polos, telah diakui sebagai penanda potensi terkait dengan kejadian kardiovaskular contohnya PJK, IL-6 juga memengaruhi tindakan beragam seluler, termasuk efek pada trombosit, endothelium, faktor metabolisme, dan koagulasi.

Pathophysiology of Heart Disease

Data suggest that exposure to secondhand smoke can result in heart disease in nonsmoking adults. Recently, progress has been made in reducing involuntary exposure to secondhand smoke through legislation banning smoking in workplaces, restaurants, and other public places. The effect of legislation to ban smoking and its effects on the cardiovascular health of nonsmoking adults, however, remains a question.
