Men Without Women

First published in 1927, *Men Without Women* represents some of Hemingway's most important and compelling early writing. In these fourteen stories, Hemingway begins to examine the themes that would occupy his later works: the casualties of war, the often uneasy relationship between men and women, sport and sportsmanship. Even though we nowadays have fast and easy access to any kind of information on literature and literary history, we encounter, more than ever, the difficulty of finding a credible overall perspective on world literary history. Unlike the prose poem, flash fiction focuses on key fictional elements like character, plot, dialogue, and drama. It is the drama and precision of the form that draws me to flash fiction. I like that in as little as one to three pages it is possible to convey complex relationships between characters. The briefness of the form presents huge challenges to writers, but it is that brevity that has allowed flash fiction to thrive over the past few decades. A key reason that readers are drawn to flash fiction is because in a few minutes of reading they can take in an entire story. The form demands as much of readers as it does of writers.

A Rose in Bloom is a collection of author A.R. Ford's short stories and poems. The Road to Nowhere is a short, romantic story taking place in the Appalachian Mountains. It explores Taylor's story as she struggles with past trauma and mental health problems. She meets Jace and an entire town willing to love her back to life. Please note that this story contains descriptions of physical abuse and traumatic reactions related to that abuse. If you are triggered or upset by such material, please do not read the story. I have included two Halloween stories written in 2019. I hope you enjoy Pale Mary's Arms and A Quiet Place. There are three stories that are different. Fishing with Grandpa is a feelgood story about the magical moments that sometimes occur when grandchildren spend time with their grandparents. . Mountain Giants was inspired when my sister shared a YouTube video about faces and giants in mountains. It is set in the Appalachian Mountains in the town of Whitesburg, Kentucky. Nana's Gone Home touches on the impact of losing a beloved family matriarch. It is set in the Appalachian Mountains. I wrote it in honor of a colleague who passed away unexpectedly. I've tossed in my poems, most of which were written from a dark place. My poetry is inspired by some of the stories people who use

drugs have told me about their deepest, darkest moments. Warning: Some of the stories mature and triggering content including descriptions of a suicide attempt and physical and mental abuse. If you are triggered or offended by such material, please do not buy the book.

The Shorter Things Collection

Welcome to my non-young-adult collection of shorter things: poetry, flash fiction, and short stories spanning various genres, including science fiction, fantasy, horror, and memoir. Every piece in this volume is under five thousand words. Sifting through my files, I collected the best of my shorter pieces written over recent years that do not fit comfortably in the young adult genre. Some of these works were the result of writing workshop exercises, and some were prompted by specific challenges, for example, National Poetry Month and various literary magazine submission themes. Fair warning-though each piece is short, they are not all sweet.

Sex World

Ron Koertge eagerly tries his talented hand at Flash Fiction. In "BFF," a teenage girl from the near-future orders friends from Amazon. A few pages later, a robot who travels what is left of the world and observes through "well-engineered eyes" claims that the sound of turbines is his lullaby. A fed-up daughter finds a foolproof way to do away with her awful mother, while in "Jesus Dog" a mysterious animal helps a broken man recover. A page from Lois Lane's diary reveals a shocking secret. Many mothers and daughters will see themselves in Ron's version of the Persephone & Demeter story. Readers are ushered aboard a mysterious train and later invited to listen in as a teacher chats with a peculiar student named Oliver Oliver. A distant relative of Leda takes her boyfriend to the arboretum with grisly results, and Mr. Weenie tells his daughter how he and her mother met. "Sex World," the title story, turns out to not be about sex at all, but heartbreak. In these and dozens more, Ron lives up to his reputation as someone who is funny the way the truly serious often are.

The Waiting House

From the author of *Hotel Obscure* ... Once an opulent hotel for lovers of the Hollywood lifestyle, today the imposing building survives, somewhere, as an apartment house for those who wait. Not all know what they're waiting for, but the residents live in flawed concert with those of undetermined existence, among relics of the past, as they wait for answers, for lost loved ones, and for purpose. While the stories feature different characters, many of whom are recurring, each tale couples with its own unique reality ... and is narrated by Conrad, the "grand master." Kenny finds a way to overcome the despair of his missing wife. Fiona lives in the shadow of her once-famous, movie-star mother. Former Santa, Alejandro, punishes himself with solitude and sadness. A disturbed woman, Carolyn, waits for her TV prince to come. And Lee is tortured by random people who slide down walls near his fourth-floor apartment. Under the same roof, each soul has a different story ... but all live in *The Waiting House*. NOTE FROM THE AUTHOR: I write characters as I hear them speak to me.
