Based on research about after-school experiences and dilemmas conducted over a four-year period with employed parents and their children, this book draws on the stories these parents and children told--often using their actual words--to emphasize the wide variety of children's after-school arrangements, children's movement over time in and out of different arrangements, and the importance to children of multiple facets of their after-school arrangements, not simply the presence or absence of an adult caretaker. The book also emphasizes that children are not randomly assigned to after-school arrangements. Rather, parents and children struggle to reach optimal solutions to what are often difficult child care dilemmas. To understand these dilemmas, and the diverse strategies that families adopt, one must attend to the individual situations of children as family members understand them. This book was written to contribute to the development of new family and work policies and practices by illuminating the difficulties families face and their consequences for children. Marilyn Wants to Know, After High School What?

This report summarizes the presentations and discussion at a workshop entitled Opportunities to Promote Child and Adolescent Development During the After-School Hours, convened on October 21, 1999. The workshop was organized by the Board on Children, Youth, and Families and its Forum on Adolescence of the National Research Council and the Institute of Medicine, with funding from the David and Lucile Packard Foundation. This workshop brought together policy makers, researchers, and practitioners to examine research on the developmental needs of children and adolescents—ages 5 to 14 years—and the types of after-school programs designed to promote the health and development of these young people. Intended to provide a forum for discussion among the various stakeholders, the workshop did not generate conclusions about the types of programs that are most effective, nor did it generate specific recommendations about after-school programs or promote a particular approach. The workshop coincided with release of the Packard Foundation's fall 1999 issue of *The Future of Children*, entitled "When School Is Out." Focusing on after-school programs, the journal provided some context for the workshop, providing a backdrop for discussing the importance of after-school programs, the types of programs that exist across the country, and the policy climate that surrounds after-school programs. This report summarizes the workshop.

After-School Centers and Youth Development

The first in a series, this study uses newly available data to describe the measurable changes in course-taking, academic achievement, educational aspirations, and college enrollment rates of American high school students in the decade since the 1983 publication of "A Nation At Risk." The study's principal findings are: (1) high school students are taking more courses, particularly in academic areas; (2) students are taking more difficult courses as well as a greater number of courses; (3) according to the National Assessment of Educational Progress, students appear to be learning more in mathematics and science; (4) the increase in academic course-taking does not appear to have adversely affected the achievement of advanced students; (5) for the most part, students with lower abilities do not appear to have suffered as a result of curricular reforms instituted since the publication of "A Nation At Risk"; (6) fewer students are dropping out of high school between 10th and 12th grade than were dropping out a decade ago; (7) students' educational aspirations are increasing; (8) the percentage of graduates going immediately on to college continues to rise; (9) enrollment in college over the past decade has increased despite dramatic increases in college costs between 1982 and 1992; (10) it is difficult to assess how increases in the academic proficiency of 17-year-olds and the percentage of high school graduates going to college affect the academic preparedness of college freshmen—that is, whereas SAT and ACT math scores increased and verbal scores decreased, the percentage of colleges and universities offering remedial instruction or tutoring increased. Services for Youth with Disabilities After Secondary School

There is an unsettledness now in after-school childcare. The stay-at-home mom years are largely over. Will children, even very young children, stay home alone or hang out with peers, risking loneliness or engaging in problem behavior? Will some new form of supervised care emerge? The authors in this collection have spent time in community after-school programs and have learned what happens there. The authors suggest that after-school programs can be an important part of a system of childcare—as long as we can find ways to build programs for small and scattered populations as well as for densely packed ones, and as long as the money to fund programs can be found.
