The action is the heart or essence of the rifle, not simply because it holds the other parts together as a unit, but because it establishes the rifle's character and

identity. The action endures. Stocks and barrels may come and go. Stocks and barrels and sights are interesting, but the action alone provides plenty of challenge for an analysis like this. Each chapter here concludes with a summary of strong and weak points. For continuity, this is put into the context of building a modern scoped sporting rifle. Evaluation on a strict historical basis, of course, may have been more appropriate for the early actions. For example, the Arisaka doesn't convert to a very attractive sporter, but that doesn't alter its historical status as a sound military weapon
