Russell's Solutions The Theory of Definite Descriptions

For Russell, the present King of France' is very different in kind from names like Scott or Bill. the present king of France' is a definite description.

Definite descriptions cannot have meaning on their own, we can only represent them if they are placed into a proposition.

If we take 'j' as John, Bx as x is Bald and Kx as x is the present King of France, we can see the difference between the statement John is bald and the present King of France is Bald.

A similar strategy will assist us in denying the existence of the King of France. Instead of representing the proposition as -(x)(x=k) we should represent it as
