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Excerpt from Reports of Cases Argued and Determined in the Supreme Court of Montana Territory, Vol. 1: From December Term, 1868, to January Term, 1873, Inclusive The Territory of Montana was organized by the act of Congress, approved May 26, 1864. The ninth section of this act vests the judicial power in a supreme court, district courts, probate courts and justices of the peace. The supreme court consists of a chief justice and two associate justices. The first term of the supreme court of Montana was held in Virginia City, the seat of government of the Territory, and commenced on May 17, 1865. During the terms that were held from May, 1865, to December, 1868, the opinions of the court in the cases that were determined were rarely delivered in writing. Orders were generally made that the judgment of the court below should be affirmed or reversed. Written opinions were filed in every case that was decided from the December term, 1868, to the January term, 1873. The records of the court before the December term, 1868, are imperfect, and the pleadings, briefs and papers, in a majority of the causes that were heard before this term, cannot be found. For these reasons this volume contains a report of the cases which were argued and determined in the supreme court of the Territory from the December term, 1868, to the January term, 1873. America Bewitched is the first major history of witchcraft in America - from the Salem witch trials of 1692 to the present day. The infamous Salem trials are etched into the consciousness of modern America, the human toll a reminder of the dangers of intolerance and persecution. The refrain 'Remember Salem!' was invoked frequently over the ensuing centuries. As time passed, the trials became a milepost measuring the distance America had progressed from its colonial past, its victims now the righteous and their persecutors the shamed. Yet the story of witchcraft did not end as the American Enlightenment dawned - a new, long, and chilling chapter was about to begin. Witchcraft after Salem was not just a story of fire-side tales, legends, and superstitions: it continued to be a matter of life and death, souring the American dream for many. We know of more people killed as witches between 1692 and the 1950s than were executed before it. Witches were part of the story of the decimation of the Native Americans, the experience of slavery and emancipation, and the immigrant experience; they were embedded in the religious and social history of the country. Yet the history of American witchcraft between the eighteenth and the twentieth century also tells a less traumatic story, one that shows how different cultures interacted and shaped each other's languages and beliefs. This is therefore much more than the tale of one persecuted community: it opens a fascinating window on the fears, prejudices, hopes, and dreams of the American people as their country rose from colony to superpower.

WHAT ARE THE FACTS? What are the facts of the case? Who are parties? What? Injury/remedy? Claims?

WHAT IS THE LEGAL QUESTION? What is the question the court is asking? The holding is the answer to this question.

WHAT IS THE ANSWER TO THAT QUESTIONS This is the court's holding The court affirms, reverses, and/or remands back to the lower court for further proceedings.

REASONING Ask yourself "Why" the court answers the question in this way. What "test" does the court use to answer the question?

ANY OTHER OPINIONS? Not all judges may agree Majority-binding precedent Dissent=Disagree with the outcome Concur= Agree with the outcome but wants to elaborate or agrees with the outcome for different reasons

HOW FIT WITH OTHER CASES? In what way does this case address issues that I've seen before?
