A Century of Horrors

The twentieth century bears the indelible imprint of both communism and Nazism. Today, it sometimes seems as if the former is all but forgotten, at least among Western elites, while our cultural memory of the latter is an inextinguishable fire. While several of the essays focus on "name" horror films such as *IT*, *Get Out*, *Hellraiser*, and *Don't Breathe*, the collection also features essays focused on horror films produced in Asia, Europe, and Latin America, and on American classic thrillers such as Alfred Hitchcock's *Psycho*. Key social issues addressed include the war on terror, poverty, the housing crisis, and the Time's Up movement. The volume grounds its analysis in the films, rather than theory, in order to explore the ways in which institutions, identities, and ideologies work within the horror genre.

Dark Forces at Work

The seemingly unwitting facade of the eighteenth-century, Georgian, townhouse hides a secret of unfathomable horror and violence. A young employee of the London International Gazette is mysteriously drawn to suicide at the infamous ghost house of Berkeley Square that triggers a series of unnatural events that takes the ambitious Jim Cartwright on a journey, which he believes will help fulfill his dream. Unaware of the true horrors that lie within the walls of number '50, ' Jim is exposed to the truth, and the journey he is forced to take leads him to his destiny . . . but not the destiny he had wished for.

50 Berkeley Square

Eighteenth-century critics believed Gothic fiction would inspire deviant sexuality, instill heretical beliefs, and encourage antisocial violence—this book puts these beliefs to the test. After examining the assumptions behind critics' fears, it considers nineteenth-century concerns about sexual deviance, showing how *Frankenstein*, *Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde*, *Dorian Gray*, and other works helped construct homosexuality as a pathological, dangerous phenomenon. It then turns to television and film, particularly *Buffy the Vampire Slayer* and David DeCoteau's direct-to-video movies, to trace Gothicized sexuality's lasting impact. Moving to heretical beliefs, *Gothic Realities* surveys ghost stories from Dickens's *A Christmas Carol* to *Poltergeist*, articulating the relationships between fiction and the "real" supernatural. Finally, it considers connections between Gothic horror and real-world violence, especially the tragedies at Columbine and Virginia Tech.

Gothic Realities

There is no cinema with such effect as that of the hallucinatory Italian horror film. From Riccardo Freda's *I Vampiri* in 1956 to *Il Cartaio* in 2004, this work recounts the origins of the genre, celebrates at length ten of its auteurs, and discusses the noteworthy films of many others associated with the genre. The

directors discussed in detail are Dario Argento, Lamberto Bava, Mario Bava, Ruggero Deodato, Lucio Fulci, Umberto Lenzi, Antonio Margheriti, Aristide Massaccesi, Bruno Mattei, and Michele Soavi. Each chapter includes a biography, a detailed career account, discussion of influences both literary and cinematic, commentary on the films, with plots and production details, and an exhaustive filmography. A second section contains short discussions and selected filmographies of other important horror directors. The work concludes with a chapter on the future of Italian horror and an appendix of important horror films by directors other than the 50 profiled. Stills, posters, and behind-the-scenes shots illustrate the book.

Italian Horror Film Directors

It Rose from the Tomb

Revised and updated since its first publication in 1990, this acclaimed critical survey covers the classic chillers produced by Universal Studios during the golden age of hollywood horror, 1931 through 1946. Trekking boldly through haunts and horrors from *The Frankenstein Monster*, *The Wolf Man*, *Count Dracula*, and *The Invisible Man*, to *The Mummy*, *Paula the Ape Woman*, *The Creeper*, and *The Inner Sanctum*, the authors offer a definitive study of the 86 films produced during this era and present a general overview of the period. Coverage of the films includes complete cast lists, credits, storyline, behind-the-scenes information, production history, critical analysis, and commentary from the cast and crew (much of it drawn from interviews by Tom Weaver, whom *USA Today* calls "the king of the monster hunters"). Unique to this edition are a new selection of photographs and poster reproductions and an appendix listing additional films of interest.

Universal Horrors

Bollywood Horrors is a wide-ranging collection that examines the religious aspects of horror imagery, representations of real-life horror in the movies, and the ways in which Hindi films have projected cinematic fears onto the screen. Part one, "Material Cultures and Prehistories of Horror in South Asia" looks at horror movie posters and song booklets and the surprising role of religion in the importation of Gothic tropes into Indian films, told through the little-known story of Sir Devendra Prasad Varma. Part two, "Cinematic Horror, Iconography and Aesthetics" examines the stereotype of the tantric magician found in Indian literature beginning in the medieval period, cinematic representations of the myth of the fearsome goddess Durga's slaying of the Buffalo Demon, and the influence of epic mythology and Hollywood thrillers on the 2002 film *Raaz*. The final part, "Cultural Horror," analyzes elements of horror in Indian cinema's depiction of human trafficking, shifting gender roles, the rape-revenge cycle, and communal violence.
