The tide had turned in my favour, on which I stood well out to sea, being some six or eight miles out, so as to catch the full tidal swing, and so as to be to windward of my course for Lundy Island: which was the main point. Had I hugged the shore, I never would have got there, for this simple reason, that the flood would have set me up the Bristol Channel, and the ebb out of it again; for I would have had to cross both those tides close-hauled, whereas, as it happened, I stemmed one of them towards the evening with a flowing sheet. The head-wind lasted throughout the afternoon, and was very light. I became aware, every now and then, of a heavy swell, which lasted for a few minutes on each occasion and then...

The book uses Bourdieu's concepts of 'illusio' – an investment of time, emotion and body into a worthwhile activity – and 'habitus', or lifeworld, alongside contemporary data sets, to examine the yacht club as a social institution, including why many boats never go out on the water, the relationship between yacht clubs and the state, and social issues as manifested in yacht clubs, such as sexism, racism and homophobia. Offering a vigorous sociological critique of yachting and sailing, this book is fascinating reading for anybody with an interest in the sociology of leisure and sport, subcultures, social theory, or social issues in wider society.

The Blockade and the Cruisers

Gradually evolving from the masted steam frigates of the mid-nineteenth century, the first modern cruiser is not easy to define, but for the sake of this book the starting point is taken to be Iris and Mercury of 1875. They were the RN's first steel-built warships; were designed primarily to be steamed rather than sailed; and formed the basis of a line of succeeding cruiser classes. The story ends

with the last armoured cruisers, which were succeeded by the first battlecruisers (originally called armoured cruisers), and with the last Third Class Cruisers (Topaze class), all conceived before 1906. Coverage, therefore, dovetails precisely with Friedman's previous book on British cruisers, although this one also includes the wartime experience of the earlier ships. The two central themes are cruisers for the fleet and cruisers for overseas operations, including (but not limited to) trade protection. The distant-waters aspect covers the belted cruisers, which were nearly capital ships, intended to deal with foreign second-class battleships in the Far East. The main enemies contemplated during this period were France and Russia, and the book includes British assessments of their strength and intentions, with judgements as to how accurate those assessments were. As would be expected of Friedman, the book is deeply researched, original in its analysis, and full of striking insights — another major contribution to the history of British warships.

British Cruisers of the Victorian Era
