Escape to the Mountain

In the late winter of 1976, Stefan and Ann Jacob with their four month old baby daughter, Ariana, drove into the village of Telegraph Creek, BC, the most remote community in all of British Columbia, Canada. The town had no electricity or television, and was 400 miles (700 km) from the nearest town and supermarket. At the end of the only road they left their van by the frozen Stikine River and went 17 miles (25 km) further down the river on the ice to live in a long abandoned homestead. This is the story of their life in the Stikine wilderness, raising a family of three children, creating their own water wheel generated electricity, growing vegetables for the town and eventually helping develop the Canadian in-river commercial salmon fishery in the Stikine River wilderness.
