Dorsey Armstrong provides a new, Modern English translation of the MORTE DARTHUR that portrays the holistic and comprehensive unity of the text as a whole, as suggested by the structure of Caxton's print, but that is based primarily on the Winchester Manuscript, which offers the most complete and accurate version of Malory's narrative. This translation makes one of the most compelling and important texts in the Arthurian tradition easily accessible to everyone—from high school students to Arthurian scholars. In addition to the complete text, Armstrong includes an introduction that discusses Malory's sources and the long-running debate surrounding the manuscript and print versions of the narrative. For ease of use, the text is keyed to both William Caxton's print version and the manuscript version edited by Eugène Vinaver. A detailed index is also included.

Sir Thomas Malory's Morte Darthur

This English version of the stories of King Arthur, "Le Morte D'Arthur" was completed in 1469-70 by Sir Thomas Malory. Malory charts the tragic disintegration of the fellowship of the Round Table, destroyed from within by warring factions.

The non-judicial confinement of women is a common event in medieval European literature and hagiography. Yet the confinement of women outside of the judicial system was not simply a fiction in the medieval period. Men too were imprisoned without trial and sometimes on mere suspicion of an offence, yet evidence suggests that there were important differences in the circumstances under which men and women were incarcerated, and in their roles in relation to non-judicial captivity. This study of the confinement of women highlights the disparity in regulation concerning male and female imprisonment in the middle ages, and gives a useful perspective on the nature of medieval law, its scope and limitations, and its interaction with royal power and prerogative. Looking at England from 1170 to 1509, the book discusses: the situations in which women might be imprisoned without formal accusation of trial; how social status, national allegiance and stage of life affected the chances of imprisonment; the relevant legal rules and norms; the extent to which legal and constitutional developments in medieval England affected women's amenability to confinement; what can be known of the experiences of women so incarcerated; and how women were involved in situations of non-judicial imprisonment, aside from themselves being prisoners.

Tolkien's Worlds

The heart is an iconic symbol in the medieval and early modern European world. The Feeling Heart in Medieval and Early Modern Europe

Andrew Lang, (born March 31, 1844, Selkirk, Selkirkshire, Scot.--died July 20, 1912, Banchory, Aberdeenshire), Scottish scholar and man of letters noted for his collections of fairy tales and translations of Homer. Educated at St. Andrews University and at Balliol College, Oxford, he held an open fellowship at Merton College until 1875, when he moved to London. He quickly became famous for his critical articles in *The Daily News* and other papers. He displayed talent as a poet in *Ballads and Lyrics of Old France* (1872), *Helen of Troy* (1882), and *Grass of Parnassus* (1888) and as a novelist with *The Mark of Cain* (1886) and *The Disentangled* (1902). He earned special praise for his 12-volume collection of fairy tales, the first volume of which was *The Blue Fairy Book* (1889) and the last *The Lilac Fairy Book* (1910). His own fairy tales, *The Gold of Fairnilee* (1888), *Prince Prigio* (1889), and *Prince Ricardo of Pantouflia* (1893) became children's classics. Lang also did important pioneer work in such volumes as *Custom and Myth* (1884) and *Myth, Ritual and Religion* (1887). Later he turned to history and historical mysteries, notably *Pickle the Spy* (1897), *A History of Scotland from the Roman Occupation*, 4 vol. (1900-07), *Historical Mysteries* (1904), and *The Maid of France* (1908). His lifelong devotion to Homer produced well-known prose translations of the *Odyssey* (1879), in collaboration with S.H. Butcher, and of the *Iliad* (1883), with Walter Leaf and Ernest Myers. He defended the theory of the unity of Homeric literature, and his *World of Homer* (1910) is an important study. Tales of King Arthur and the Round Table

Tolkien and Shakespeare: one a prolific popular dramatist and poet of the Elizabethan era, the other a twentieth-century scholar of Old English and author of a considerably smaller body of work. Though unquestionably very different writers, the two have more in common than one might expect. These essays focus on the broad themes and motifs which concerned both authors. They seek to uncover Shakespeare's influence on Tolkien through echoes of the playwright's themes and even word choices, discovering how Tolkien used, revised, updated, "corrected," and otherwise held an ongoing dialogue with Shakespeare's works. The depiction of Elves and the world of Faerie, and how humans interact with them, are some of the most obvious points of comparison and difference for the two writers. Both Tolkien and Shakespeare deeply explored the uses and abuses of power with princes, politics, war, and the lessons of history. Magic and prophecy were also of great concern to both authors, and the works of both are full of encounters with the Other: masks and disguises, mirrors that hide and reveal, or seeing stones that show only part of the truth.
