We are sequencing an incredible number of viral genomesa the data is available and analyzed within days

So, what should you do?

Should we shelter-in-place despite the economic imp! This is a false dichotomy

Widespread encroachment on natural areas, an increases in livestock production, as well as increase the exotic animal trade.

Dense urban areas where transmission is rapid, favoring virulent strains

An interconnected globe where diseasesc rapidly migrate and reach pandemic levels

In fact, viruses are a dominant driver of protein evolution in mammals

A growing realization that evolution is important to medicine

Yet, evolutionary biologists are rarely members of medical faculty
