From observations made during the study, the general climate is believed to be similar to that of other alpine areas in the Rocky Mountain region. Winds are predominantly northwesterly and strong (20 - 30 km/h) throughout the year. Summer temperature data that might be extrapolated to Carter Mountain were collected by Johnson and Billings (1962) on the Beartooth Plateau about 80 km to the north.
