They recognized them as canola. Farmers grow canola for seeds to make cooking oil. Canola is also used for animal feed and biofuel.

The researchers decided to test the plants. They had brought along special testing papers for the project they were working on.

The results showed that the weedy canola plants contained genetic changes.

Some crop plants are modified to resist damage from the chemicals that farmers spray to kill weeds. One protein gives resistance against glyphosate.

Professor Sagers says canola varieties with these genetic qualities have not been released on the market.
