Brahma Sutra . Systematically analyzes the teachings of the Upanishads. • Arrives at logical conclusions without contradictions. • Defense of all Vedantic schools. • Sankhya, Purva-Mimamsa and Buddhism were prevalent, so many arguments are aimed against those schools. • It should be noted that it defends all Vedanta schools and does not deal with differences between them.

Approach Brahma Sutra consists of 555 sutras, or aphorisms - short, pithy statements packed with content - meant to be easily memorized. Even for a person who is familiar with the Upanishads, it is extremely difficult to extract the full teaching from the text. Thankfully, there are many commentaries and sub- commentaries that help us.

What is a Sutra? Sutra literally means thread (which holds ideas together). A Sutra must satisfy these six elements: 1. Alpaaksharam - Few words 2. Asandighdam - Unambiguous 3. Saaravat - Captures essence 4. Viswatomukham - Comprehensive presentation 5. Asthobham - No fillers or repetitions 6. Anavadyam - Irrefutable

How can we identify the main purpose or central theme? Six indicators (shad-lingani): 1. Upakramo, Upasamharau - mentioned in the beginning and end; start with a capsule summary and end with the same. 2. Abyaso - repetition - the central theme is usually repeated 3. Apoorvata - newness - it is a topic not previously known 4. Phalam-mention of benefit 5. Artha-voda - glorification 6. Upapatti - logic/reason
