I pray I have chosen wisely and that this NLV compilation becomes a daily resource for you! I suggest you spend just a few minutes each day reading one short Bible verse, and then consider, with the help of the commentary immediately after each verse, the verses' relevance in your life that particular day. If you read and consider just one verse grouping each day, my hope is that you will intimately grasp the essence of the Bible story, from beginning to end, in just six months time! Further, this NLV resource has only about 57,000 words. That compares favorably to the 800,000 words in the Bible. Heck, if you get to the end of this short NLV compilation inspired and maybe even discover you have become a better person, perhaps you might circle back and use the Biblical appendix in my 2011 book to delve deeper into God's Word.
