The newspaper that succeeded the "National Intelligencer & Washington Advertiser" was the "National Intelligencer" distinct from the "Daily National Intelligencer," another newspaper. Of course, as newspapers go, the "National Intelligencer" may have adopted the word "Daily" for a while. To make matters more confusing, the District of Columbia had 2 papers named the "National Intelligencer" along with the "Daily" paper.
