There are 29 surviving promontory forts along a 24km stretch of coastline

Promontory forts were constructed on natural promontories above steep cliffs

where they were separated from the mainland by a small neck of land

At Ballyvoyle Head three promontory forts are located

The tower may have been part of a system for sending telegraphs along the coast to warn of French invasions

At Ballydowane Bay there are promontory forts on the east and the west side of the bay

The grass covered steeply sloping offshore island is called Saint John's Island

The name of the townland Ballydowane is translated as homestead of Duane

The adits (entrances to underground mines) in the cliffs, along with shafts, spoil heaps, ore yards and engine houses on the coast, provide evidence of this former industry

Beside the Knockmahon promontory fort, at Stage Cove, there is an artificially-cleared landing place At Tankardstown, a 19th-century copper mining complex can be seen above the cliffs

There are two more promontory forts near Tankardstown, at Drumboe and Drumcappal

Drumcappal Promontory Fort

Annestown Beach is located in a bay that has a promontory fort on the east and on the west side. The westernmost fort is severely eroded and inaccessible from the land and the shore. This 1849 illustration of Annestown Beach (from UKHO) shows the late medieval Dunhill Castle. The lime kiln is still there today and suggests that the beach was used as a landing place. The coastline at Woodstown promontory fort has clear evidence of coastal erosion over several centuries.
