EQ: A Foundational Skill - Marginal factor that can have tremendous impact . May assist in ensuring future success - Not the only factor, but nonetheless an important one - Examples from business realm: CEOs! What can we learn and apply to our workspace?

Support those whom you empower Stand by decisions of others when you have empowered them with responsibility – don't undermine . Key example: Chief Residents - Issues of Law - policies & procedures Sometimes non-negotiable to keep system fair, equitable & transparent - Issues of Fact - interpretation/gray zone . Always err on the side of upholding

Embrace the difficult conversation . Much better than no conversation at all! . Good Will vs. Bad Faith - Good Will: even if decision is not in one's favor, most will appreciate and respect - Bad Faith: lack of conversation leads to deeper wounds that are difficult to heal

Place yourself in other's shoes...often . How would I react to this conversation? . How would I react if I received this email? - What sort of communication would elicit an entirely different response in me? The treachery of e- communications Intent # Interpretation ! - Emails - Text messages - Tweets - The power of in-person chats - or perhaps even an old school phone call! - Self-embargo before you hit "reply"

Actively manage change Change is tough = human nature - Actively manage the process - Gain buy-in by speaking to stakeholders - Pre-vet contentious issues Never underestimate the impact of change on a team/organization - Impact on individuals, collateral impacts Use the "heads-up" method

Beware the holidays - Winter is a tough time in the academic (err..."FY") calendar - Short days, bad weather - Glimmer of fresh start in July has faded - Road to June seems distant - Requires additional sensitivity . Be particularly mindful of this when enacting/effecting change

Step-back from emotional "triggers" - EP's: we often roll on pattern recognition ' pre-wired response . Take a step-back ' re-examine "we would like to talk about our clinical hours...or our schedule" . Don't just react! - Take a step back, analyze, sound

Be reasonable, transparent, consistent Reasonable: Communicate your rationale - Others may not like the decision, but genuine, sincere & sound rationale key - Transparent: Sound policies & procedures that are clear to all . Consistent: Do for one only as you would be able to do for "X" - Key in diffusing difficult situations
