grow large vegetables and containers

form a nice fibrous root ball

pre-moistened the soil

add another bag of soil

adding a couple of scoops of the vermis terra

add some organic fertilizer

install drip irrigation in all of my containers

loosen the roots up just a bit

train this plant up through the cage

add a nice little pop of color to each container

add some shredded leaf mulch here to the top

using shredded leaf mulch

start the seeds

plant seeds directly in the containers

support them with these tall eight-foot poles

weave it in between the wires

push all the way down into the bottom of the container

grow a nice fibrous root ball

twist it very gently from the stem

feeding the leaves up through the tomato cage

hand pollinate your zucchini

growing a nice crop of zucchini in a container

sticking your finger in the container

adding 6 ounces to my 2 gallon watering container

notice the leaves are drooping

adding calcium to the soil

sprinkle that around the base of my plant

avoid getting the leaves wet

coats your leaves with a protective film of beneficial bacteria

snip off the leaf as close to the base of the plant

share with you three tips for growing watermelons successfully in a container

form a nice fibrous root mass

growing up in between the mesh on your trellis

tied around the stem

tap the male flower onto the female flower several times

pollinate the small immature fruit

fertilizer container plants

a pair of pantyhose for smaller watermelons

tie it to the trellis

grown watermelon in containers before growing them vertically on a trellis

check the tendril

find the tendril
