What is a cardiac biomarker? - A substance that is specific to the heart. - Released in proportion to injury or disease. • B-type natriuretic peptide (BNP) is produced in the ventricular and atrial myocytes. . Stress or stretch of the myocardium ' proBNP • ProBNP ' N-terminal and C-terminal fragments ° vasodilation, natriuresis and diuresis

Differentiating cardiac vs. noncardiac causes of respiratory signs. - Not a stand alone test - use after taking thoracic radiographs - KEY POINT: A low/normal value helps rule out congestive heart failure. Detecting occult cardiomyopathy in Dobermans and cats. - Gold standard remains echocardiography and

Predicting morbidity and mortality in dogs with heart disease. -Dogs with preclinical CDVD, radiographic or echocardiographic heart enlargement, and NT-proBNP 1500 pmol/L are likely at an increased risk for the development of CHF (6x higher in the next 3-6 months).

How to Recognize Cardiac Disease: Summary Key differences between dogs and cats: - Dogs usually have murmurs. Cats may not. - Does cough. Cats typically do not. -Dogs show clinical signs sooner. - Cats with heart disease experience arterial thromboembolisms. - Radiographs are much more sensitive with dogs.

Torsemide (torasemide): • Potent loop diuretic - Excretion of Na^+ , K^+ , Cl^- , and water. • Loop diuretics are the most important aspect of treatment of CHF in pets and humans. . Compared to furosemide: - Higher bioavailability - Longer half-life - Longer duration of action

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
