A search warrant is a crucial legal document issued by a judge or magistrate, authorizing law enforcement officials to conduct a search of a specific person, location, or vehicle for evidence of a crime. This critical police authority is typically granted only upon a showing of probable cause, ensuring constitutional protections are upheld during a criminal investigation.
